Chuck Covert moved to approve the minutes with the correction of the word “note”
under New Business, page 2, item #1. Jaime Van Den Bosch seconded the motion.
Correction will be made and minutes were approved as corrected.

PUBLIC COMMENT/AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION/PRESENTATIONS:

OLD BUSINESS:

1) Status of Brewery Grade Crosswalk Project

Dale McCabe reported that the new option #3 was approved and the concrete work will
be contracted out and the City is looking at a fall completion date.

2) Status of Stop Sign at Boat Basin

Dale said he had no new information regarding the stop sign.

3) Status of Traffic Study on Kelly Avenue

Dale reported the Traffic Study on Kelly Avenue had been wrapped up but the City has
not received the final report yet. He did let members know that there would be some
changes to the crosswalk on 11th and there would be some loss of parking in the area.

4) Speed Limits Questions on 3rd Street and W 2nd Street

John Nelson asked about the correct speed limits on 3rd Street, between Lincoln and 3rd
Place and on “W 2nd Street west of Webber. Questions will be forwarded to Chief
Waterbury for discussion at July meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

1) Resignation of Duane Howell

Cindy Kever reported that Duane had resigned from the Traffic Safety Commission. Duane wanted to thank everyone for their support and dedication and wanted to let people know he had enjoyed serving on the commission board.

2) Update of City Paving Projects

Dale reported the City has not received the final report regarding the Traffic Study on Kelly Avenue. He did not know all of the particulars on the study, but did tell members there would be more defined crosswalks at 11th and this will affect some parking on 11th Street.

3) Concrete Sidewalks across 2nd Street

Discussion was held regarding the "speed bumps" on 2nd Street where the asphalt road meets the concrete sidewalks that go across 2nd Street. Chuck Covert is going to speak to Dan Durow regarding future plans for improvements and will report his findings at a future meeting.

4) Festival Areas around The Dalles

Discussion was held regarding the fencing next to the railroad tracks at the new festival area. Dale said there would be some kind of permanent fence installed.

Tim McGlothlin also updated members regarding the park area by the new skate park. Building is in need of extensive repairs, so it was decided it will be torn down and the Lewis and Clark memorial will be moved to another location.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, Frank Pyles moved to adjourn. Jim Bishop seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
